GENERAL INFORMATION

This is an ASCA sanctioned show and all trials will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA. Dogs over 6 months of age must have proof of ASCA registration available. SCASC, the Show Secretaries and club membership assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by any exhibitor, handler, dog, property, children or spectator. All dogs must be crated or leashed except while competing.

Entry fees will not be returned if the show cannot be opened or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of SCASC. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the Show Committee, ASCA, show veterinarian or the judge.

All shows/trials will be held indoor. Conformation shows will be held on carpet and rally and obedience will be on mats. Grooming spaces are available in both buildings with electricity. You may need an extension cord to reach the electricity.

Pre-Entry Deadline: Postmark no later than January 15, 2012. Telephone, facsimile or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries must be on the official ASCA entry form with proper fees included. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of the entry and the class entered. Withdrawals of entries will be accepted until the Pre-entry closing. Thereafter, no refunds will be made.

Conformation Trophies: In lieu of trophies, Southern Colorado will be putting the funds usually spent in this area towards their trophy budget for the 2013 National Specialty Pre-Show that we are hosting. Thank you for your understanding.

Conformation Ribbons: Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in the classes. Deluxe rosettes for BOB, BOW, BOS, WD, WB, RWD, RWB, Best Junior, Reserve Junior, BOB Puppy and BOS Puppy.

Show Photographer: A Show photographer will be available for ALL win photos and some ringside (arena) photos. Photographing over the Photographers shoulder is strictly prohibited. Any private photos taken must not include the photographers Signage.

Directions from the North:

Take I-25 south to the Plum Creek Exit #181. Turn left at the signal onto Plum Creek Parkway. Go east on Plum Creek Parkway, approximately one mile to Fairgrounds Road (the 3rd signal light). Turn left on Fairgrounds Road.

Directions from the South:

Take I-25 north to the Plum Creek Exit #181. Turn left onto Wilcox Street. Turn right onto Plum Creek Parkway at the signal light. Go east on Plum Creek Parkway, approximately one mile to Fairgrounds Road. Turn left on Fairgrounds Road.
